He enjoys getting out accessing the community when his anxiety allows him to. He enjoys going out to visit various national trust parks, Ikea, Cheshire oaks, etc. He would require support to go to all these places as well as food shopping and medical appointments, therefore a driver would be required. Ryan already has a small staff team in place but is looking to get some more on board. He has a number of shifts available we can discuss more in detail when meeting with Ryan. Full training will be provided for any new staff.

The current shift times are 10.30am to 2.30pm and 4pm to 8pm every day.
